Group exercise for Steps 3

The same country teams as in the morning will be formed.


STEP 3 (1 HOUR 40 MIN)

• Review the goals defined in the morning and **pick the 1-3 most important ones** (group voting).



Group exercise for Steps 3

- Participants will write down individually on cards technologies and policies that could potentially help achieving the goals (Max 2 – 1 technology and 1 policy)
- Participants will **plot the card along two key dimensions**: (i) whether it has been tried before or not and (ii) the degree of perceived success of past experiences.
- Team members will try to identify patterns/clusters and redefine key priority technologies and policies (specify which goals the technology/policy relate to).
- Team members will rank the most important interventions (technologies & policies) using stickers.



Group exercise for Steps 3

 Based on prioritized set of technologies and policies, group members will discuss the likely time of implementation of these technologies and policies and put them on a timeline.




